The first activity picks up on the work around word families looked at in the activities for Part 1. Student look at words related to power.

The second activity focuses on conditional sentences used in the episode. These sentences use the first conditional.

The last activity asks students to produce a sentence in the first and second conditional.

This is to provide an opportunity for language focus in the classroom. It could be continues with a discussion about “If I was the Prime Minister....”
